Race is +1 for EACH Advanced Player on team, +2 for each Master. With a Maximum of +2. To help meet desired estimated time-to-finish target... When "+" adjusted teams play each other, "lower" team races to baseline. I.e. Assuming baseline of 5, if a +1 Open/Advanced team plays a +2 Advanced/Master team (normally that race would be 6-7), their race will be 5-6 ALL RACES AND STARTING TIMES ARE "BEST-EFFORT" AND MAY BE ADJUSTED FOR NUMBER OF ENTRIES, NUMBER OF TABLES, AND/OR TIME ALLOWED. The LEAGUE OPERATOR and PLAYERS agree to the following: 1. Entry fees and registration fees for the appropriate division in the form of a cashier's check or money order (no personal checks!) are to be submitted with this entry form **TO YOUR LOCAL LEAGUE OPERATOR.** 2. All players must have a minimum of 5 weeks of play since June 1st of the current 2014/2015 season in their local league, and meet ACS Amateur requirements. All players must be current members, in good standing, of their local league and be a sanctioned member of the Louisiana ACS Billiards Association. NOTE: Louisiana resident requirement is temporarily/on-a-trial-basis removed providing there is no abuse of this. BUT non-Louisiana-resident player MUST meet all previously stated criteria; be an active league player in the local LABA sanctioned league in which they qualify; and must have TWICE the minimum number of games to qualify... for this tournament that would be 10 weeks of play since June 1st of the current 2014/2015 season. 3. Check In: Singles players agree to check in at the tournament site by 11:00am, Friday, April 10th for a player's meeting and Calcutta, and be ready to play immediately following the Calcutta. Scotch Doubles teams (must be male/female and from the same League) agree to check in at the tournament site by 12:00 Noon on Saturday, April 11th for a player's meeting & Calcutta, and be ready to play immediately following the Calcutta. 4. All players agree to the tournament dress code as follows: (a) collared shirts worn with slacks or dress jeans (no cutoffs, shorts, ripped or torn jeans or swimwear). (b) Clean, neat, closed-toed shoes. Ladies may wear sandals (not flip-flops). Dress code must be adhered to regardless of player/team mutual agreement. Violators of any of the above rules may be disqualified from this tournament. By signing this entry form, the players acknowledge that they have received and read the regulations of this tournament.
